FAITH WORKS Book of James Study Program

BACKGROUND:

A relationship with Christ brings with it a responsibility to make a difference in our world. Faith in Christ produces a natural outflow of service to others. Believers should be concerned with the well-being of those around them, and they must act on those concerns, choosing to sacrifice self-comfort for the good of others. Everything we do should bring glory to God so that others will be drawn to Him through our actions.

DAY 1: READ JAMES 2:14-17

- 1. When in your life have you had difficulty walking out your faith?
- 2. Would others say that your walk matches your talk? Why or why not?
- 3. How can you go the extra mile to help others whom you come in contact with?
- 4. How are faith and works related? How is God honored when the two work together?

Pray: Lord, teach me to pay attention to the good You want to do in this world. Help me to be intentional as I seek to be Your hands and feet in the world. Give me the courage to walk in a vibrant faith that is alive and useful for Your Kingdom. Amen.

DAY 2: READ JAMES 2:18-26

- 1. What is required of your faith that brings you to a level higher than just believing (like the demons)?
- 2. What does an "active" faith look like?
- 3. What does it mean to be called a "friend" of God?
- 4. How do you explain the understanding that "faith without works" is dead?

Pray: Father, help me to be active in my faith, living up to Your desires. Teach me what it means to be Your friend. Help me to live as more than just a believer. Thank you, God, for loving me the way You do. Amen.

DAY 3: READ MATTHEW 5:13-16

- 1. How does your life glorify God?
- 2. How are you intentionally living for Christ in front of others?
- 3. Has there ever been a time when your faith-walk has lost its saltiness? Describe that time.
- 4. How can you more effectively "let your light shine before others"?

Pray: Lord, help me to live a life that makes a difference in the world around me. Show me how to bring glory to You in everything I do. Keep me "salty" as I serve You, and give me opportunities to share Your love with others. Amen.

DAY 4: READ HEBREWS 13:1-8

- 1. How could you, in our cultural context, show hospitality to strangers?
- 2. What is one way you currently serve others?
- 3. How could you serve those in God's Kingdom more effectively?
- 4. Whose life are you imitating and why?

Pray: Father, teach me to show hospitality to others, regardless of the circumstances. Help me to follow You and become a servant of everyone, loving as You do. Direct me to people I should imitate in life those with incredible faith who seek You with their whole hearts. Amen.
