Acts 2:41-47, ESV – ⁴¹ So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls. ⁴² And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. ⁴³ And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. ⁴⁴ And all who believed were together and had all things in common. ⁴⁵ And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. ⁴⁶ And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.


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QUICK REVIEW

ENGAGE WITH THE MESSAGE

Hebrews 10:24-25, ESV – ²⁴ And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

- Looking at Acts 5:42, we see the early church gathering in two locations. Why are each of these locations important for church gatherings?
- Why does the author of Hebrews encourage believers to gather and to not neglect meeting together?
- Can a follower of Jesus grow and be on mission with Jesus by attending only one of the two gatherings discussed (large group or small group)? Why or why not?
- **2 Timothy 2:1-2, ESV** You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus, ² and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also.

Colossians 3:16, ESV – ¹⁶ Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

- According to the passage above, what benefits can be found in a small group setting? Explain.
- In life groups, we talk all the time about "doing life together." What does that mean to you? What does it look like?
