

Sermon: Going To A Throwdown Lead Pastor Mark Saunders Summer Study Program - Page 1



Background:

Antioch was the center for missionary activities, and the base for Paul's ministries. The leaders in the church at Antioch were very diverse in background, and in race.

As the church was fasting and praying, waiting to hear from God, He spoke to them, asking them to send out their best. Paul was obviously gifted as an evangelist, and Barnabas was a gifted encourager. The church was told to set them apart, to prepare them to leave. Keep in mind, in that time, when missionaries left, there was every possibility they might never return, or it might be years before they did return.

We must remember that, as Christians, what we do is centered on moving the kingdom of God forward. As difficult as it may have been for the church to send out their best, they were committed to obedience to the Lord, even when that obedience was costly. Opposition to the gospel, for selfish reasons, is common in Acts.

Cyprus was the homeland of Barnabas, and Salamis was the largest city on the eastern side of Cyprus. Paphos was about 100 miles from there.

This was a personal call for Paul, a congregational affirmation for that ministry, and God's plan for the early church. Paul's true and strong teaching was led by the Holy Spirit, and thus very effective.



Opening Questions:

When was the last time you had to say goodbye to someone you loved, who was going away for a long trip? How did you feel?

How are you fitting into God's plan for spreading the gospel, and advancing God's Kingdom?

Have you ever felt like God has called you to a particular area of ministry? How did you answer that call?
