Sermon: How We Don't

Key Passage: Titus 1:10-16 (ESV)

Getting Started

1. What had the most impact on you from this weekend's sermon? How will you use what you've heard?
2. Have you ever had really bad service? What did it look like? What does good service look like for you? How do you serve well?
3. Take some time to read Titus 1:10-16. Make note of what stands out to you. What are you noticing about the passage as a whole? What verse speaks loudest to where you're at right now?
4. What do verses 10 and 11 say about those who have been circumcised? Who is the author referring to when they write "Those of the circumcision party"? What do you think it means to *teach for shameful gain*?

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5. Cretans were Greeks who lived on the island of Crete, what is the significance of what their prophet says about them? What does Paul command to do to the Cretans, what does is the ultimate goal there?

6. Discuss verses 15 and 16 in your group. What does this mean to be pure or not pure? What would it look like in our world to profess to know God, but deny him by works? What does it mean to be unfit for any good work?

7. Take a moment to read 2 Timothy 4:1-5. How will you preach the word, reprove, rebuke, and exhort with patience and love? What does it mean to be in season and out of season? What does verse 5 instruct us to do and what does it mean?

8. How has scripture changed your perspective? How have you used scripture to help yourself get out of hard seasons? How can you use scripture to get others out of hard seasons.
