Passage Only - Luke 6:37-49 (ESV)

36 Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful.



37 "Judge not, and you will not be judged; condemn not, and you will not be condemned; forgive, and you will be forgiven; 38 give, and it will be given to you. Good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap. For with the measure you use it will be measured back to you."

39 He also told them a parable: "Can a blind man lead a blind man? Will they not both fall into a pit? 40 A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone when he is fully trained will be like his teacher. 41 Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? 42 How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me take out the speck that is in your eye,' when you yourself do not see the log that is in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take out the speck that is in your brother's eye.


A Tree and Its Fruit

43 "For no good tree bears bad fruit, nor again does a bad tree bear good fruit, 44 for each tree is known by its own fruit. For figs are not gathered from thornbushes, nor are grapes picked from a bramble bush. 45 The good person out of the good treasure of his heart produces good, and the evil person out of his evil treasure produces evil, for out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.

Build Your House on the Rock

46 "Why do you call me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do what I tell you? 47 Everyone who comes to me and hears my words and does them, I will show you what he is like: 48 he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. 49 But the one who hears and does not do them is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great."






Life Group Study Notes Week of Sunday, Mar 22

4. Read Luke 6:43-45. Do your words portray the way you feel in your heart? Why or why not? Are there any areas where you have difficulty being authentic in your actions and your speech?



5. Read Luke 6:46-49. What is the foundation of your faith built upon? How can you strengthen that foundation?
6. Each of these sections of Scripture teaches us about the necessity for our faith to be an active faith. In what areas of your faith journey are you more actively moving forward? In what areas are you a bit too passive?
7. Choose a person in your group or in your friend base and ask them to hold you accountable to be more active in your faith journey.
